

## **Liberation and Freedom Days: Reparations Run/Walk**

The Reparations Run/Walk is a fun community event and will take place March 1-6. We are raising funds to support the Jefferson School African American Heritage Center Teacher Training Program, the NAACP's Youth Council, Vinegar Hill Magazine's Black Business advertising fund, We Code Too, African American Teaching Fellows and 101.3 JAMZ. These organizations all have Black leadership and support the community directly. Our goal is to support them by raising \$45,000 that will be divided between the six organizations.

The 9.03 mile route, which allows you to appreciate some of Charlottesville's rolling hills, also lets you engage with some of the City's African American businesses and important sites of local African American history. See below for further details on how to participate. Once registered, you can choose to run/walk this route anytime during the week of March 1st.

### **There are 3 ways to participate:**

1. **Register for the run/walk:** The registration for the event will be done through the above link. There is no fee to register for the race, but make sure to make a donation in support after registration.
2. **Register as a Fundraiser:** Register as a [fundraiser](#) and encourage others to help you meet a donation goal. When registering, sign up as a fundraiser and build a team. Pledges are accepted at the fundraiser level.
3. **Make a donation:** Not able to participate in the event, but still want to support? Click the "Donate" button at the top of the race page and follow the prompts.
